While the Troop did not have an overnight outing in June, it was still a busy month with 2 day hikes, Troop BBQ, Court of Honor and AOL Ceremony.


The first June day hike took Scouts down to the beach in North Edmonds and along the coast for several miles before climbing back out of the infamous Edmonds bowl. As
