Passport Reminder for Vancouver

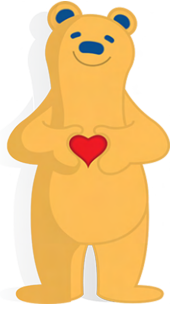
